WHAT IS HOPE?

HOPE aids individuals and their family members in navigating through a first episode of psychosis by assisting with stabilizing their psychotic symptoms.

What is first episode psychosis?

First episode psychosis is characterized by a period of time when a person experiences disruptive thoughts or perceptions that make it difficult for them to know what is real.

This can include:

- Seeing, hearing, and believing things that are not real
- Suspiciousness
- Persistent unusual thoughts and beliefs
- Strong emotions or lack of emotions
- Withdrawal from support systems
- Decline in self-care or hygiene
- Trouble concentrating

GOALS

HOPE focuses on supporting individuals with maintaining interpersonal relationships, achieving their educational and employment aspirations, and improving their quality of life.

HOPE utilizes a multi-dimensional treatment approach that includes:

- Case Management
- Family Support and Education
- Outpatient Therapy
- Medication Management
- Supported Employment
 and Education



Eligibility

- Client must be between the ages of 15-35
- Have a diagnosis of schizophrenia, schizoaffective disorder, or schizofreniform
- Or be experiencing early symptoms or a recent onset of psychosis
