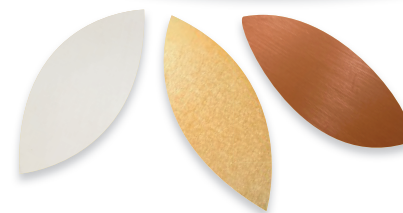

Giving Tree



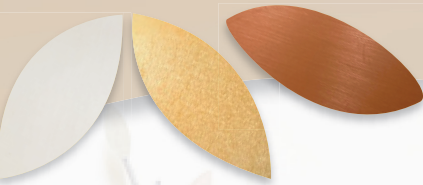
The Center for Life Management Giving Tree

The board and staff of the Center for Life Management (CLM) named the donor tree, the Giving Tree perhaps in homage to Shel Silverstein, who wrote and illustrated "The Giving Tree," first published in 1964 by Harper & Row. Our story, much like the plot in Silverstein's book, is a beautiful story of selfless generosity befitting the generous gifts that empower CLM to continue to lift the human spirit with the treatment of mental illness. Relying on gifts from others builds the charitable foundation enabling CLM to offer programs and services that help clients live independently while managing their mental illness.

This hand forged "Tree of Life" sculpture was created by David Little of Winnepesaukee Forge, located in Meredith, NH. David is a state juried artist blacksmith with the NH League of Craftsmen and has been working at his craft for more than 40 years. "I'm so proud that we can do this for CLM," explained Little. Although he has many donor sculptures throughout the US, this donor tree is his first in New Hampshire.

"Having one of my trees here in New Hampshire and sharing in the mission of this organization is immensely gratifying. These folks do great work and I'm so glad that I can be a part of it. I hope that together we reach the hearts of many people who enjoy the tree's beauty as well as what it stands for, -inspirational giving," concluded Little.
