

CHILD IMPACT PROGRAM



The Child Impact Program (CIP) provides information to help parents better understand the impact of divorce or custody changes on their children. The program teaches skills that will enable parents to make choices and decisions that will be consistent with a child's emotional and developmental needs.

Program Schedule

The program is presented in two, two-hour sessions or as one, four-hour session. The program is led by a pair of experienced CIP instructors for classes of up to 20 participants.

Please note that this program is not designed to provide legal consultation, mediation or group therapy.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

Topics Covered:

By the end of the program, parents will have a basic understanding of the following issues:

- Ways to promote self-esteem in your child during this difficult time
- · What you can do to help your children adjust
- The impact of violence or chronic conflict upon children
- · Behaviors to avoid
- Helpful communication styles
- Effective co-parenting skills
- How to be a role model
- Alternative dispute resolution
- The stages of grief and loss that children may experience
- How parents can respond to troubling behaviors and events in ways that are helpful

Things to Keep in Mind:

- Children are not allowed to attend the class.
- Classes begin on time and participants should arrive 15 minutes early. Late arrivals will not be admitted to class and fees are non-refundable.
- Upon completion of four hours of class time, a Certificate of Completion will be mailed to you and your Family Division Court.

Classes are held by video or in-person at the CLM MAIN Office, 10 Tsienneto Road in Derry, NH.

Pre-registration is required.

Program fee is \$85 per person.

Payment must be received at time of registration.

A fee reduction will only be considered for those who meet specific financial qualifications.
